Parental Consultation Toilet use in School Time

Seeking your views on changes to our approach to children going to the toilet in lesson time

We are aware of a small number of children with medical needs who need access to the toilet throughout the day. Following conversations with families and the sharing of medical information, these children are issued toilet passes which they use to show that they have permission to leave lessons. In addition to those children, we have a significant number of children are currently missing substantial amounts of learning time by asking to use the toilet during lesson time. We are keen to work with you, our staff and our children to look at how we can resolve this problem, allow the children reasonable time to use the toilets but reduce the impact on their learning.

Currently we allow children to use the toilet at break time and lunch time. We discourage them from using the toilet during lessons, but currently do allow them to go during the middle 20 minutes of our lessons if they say they need to. Until the summer, we felt this was essential because there was no time between lessons to go to the toilet. This meant children may have had to wait for 2 hours at a time.

From September we made changes to our school day. There is now a five-minute changeover time between our one-hour lessons. The children are encouraged to use the toilet between lessons and at break time and lunch time. This means children currently have seven opportunities every day to use the toilet, at least once every hour. With that in mind we would like to move to not allowing children to go to the toilet during lesson time. We welcome your views on this proposal and would ask that you complete this short form so that we can include your thoughts in our plans.

Huge congratulations to all the players!








Cheshire Schools' Book Award 2024

We look forward to reading the nominated books over the academic year and picking our favourites in May 2024.


















Stem Club News
